Some general requirements:

- Any lighting or electrical components should be outdoor-rated;

- Plans should be shared with the planning committee (Mike Brown or Susan Randolph can bring details to the group) so we can ensure that each feature works with event plans and logistics (as well as "vintage" electrical circuits).
